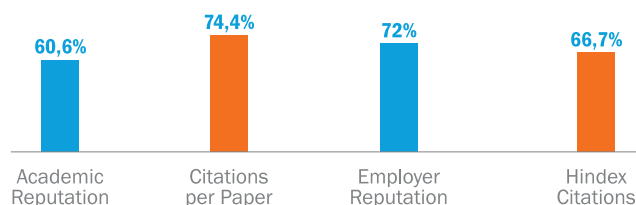

HISTORY

The origins and academic tradition of the Faculty of Architecture of VGTU dates back to the first half of the XX th century. In 1971 the Faculty of Architecture was moved from Kaunas to Vilnius and became a part of newly established VISI (Vilnius Institute of Construction and Technology). In 1990 VISI was named Vilnius Technical University (VTU) and finally in 1996 – Vilnius Gediminas Technical University.

FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE TODAY: STRUCTURE AND STUDIES

VGTU Faculty of Architecture is the largest institution of higher education in the field of Architecture in Lithuania. Over 500 students of all levels are studying in the school today. Many of our academic staff members are leading authorities in their field.

In Lithuania, Bachelor degree diploma validates professional qualification of an architect. Those who want to continue their studies can choose between several specializations available in Master degree studies: Architecture of Buildings, Urban Design as well as separate program of History and Theory of Architecture (Humanitarian Sciences).
